
Any questions, give us a call at the Extension office.

## Southern Classic Youth Livestock Project Experience

is scheduled for December 7-9, 2012 in Brazos County. This multi-county/regional event is conducted by Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service.


The primary focus of the weekend activities are centered on educational programs for beef cattle (steers and heifers), swine, meat goats, lambs, poultry and **rabbits (new this year**).

On Saturday, multiple showmanship workshops will be conducted to help new exhibitors in addition to specie specific programs. A set of large animal clippers will be given away during the beef, lamb, goat and swine clinics. The targeted audience is families with limited experience feeding and exhibiting livestock; although, participation is open to all 4-H and FFA members regardless of knowledge and ability.

All youth participants are given a useful prize of some kind related to their livestock project. Sunday is devoted to competitive showmanship contests (novice, junior and senior divisions) followed by jackpots shows. Animals do not have to be clipped or fitted in order to participate.

Registration costs \$30/family if registered by December 2nd; otherwise, it is \$40/family and can be completed on 4-H Connect. Complete details can be found at

#### **Divisions**:

Clover Kids – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade and under (as of the start of the 2012 school year) Juniors - 3rd grade to age 13 (age as of August 31, 2012) Seniors - Ages 14-18 (age as of August 31, 2012)

#### **Classes** (all food must contain pecans, garnishing with pecans does not count):

- 1. Cake layer, tube, loaf, or bundt cake; may be butter, chiffon, or foam type
- 2. Candy fudge, divinity, pralines, pecan logs 15 pieces per entry
- 3. Cookies icebox, cut-out, shaped, drop, or bar type 12 cookies per entry
- 4. Pies cream, custard, chess, fruit
- 5. Quick breads muffins, loaf, coffee cake

#### **Entry requirements:**

A typed copy of the recipe must be submitted to the county Extension office by December 6th by email to <u>ncdobbins@ag.tamu.edu</u> If email is not available then bring a typed copy of the recipe to the office in person, so that a recipe book can be made. This will serve as your "entry." A confirmation email will be sent on Friday, December 8<sup>th</sup> with all entries listed. Baked entries must be checked in between 7:45 -8:30 a.m. and awards can be picked up between 3:00 - 5:00 p.m. on December 18<sup>th</sup> Please note ---some baked items will be used for an Elected Officials reception that day. It is a closed judging process, so no participant or representative of a participant will be allowed in the judging area before 3PM. Baked items can be dropped off by anyone, youth are not required to. All entries should be displayed on disposable paper or aluminum plates or covered cardboard, no glass, metal or plastic plates or pans are allowed. Entries should be covered with a zip-loc plastic bag or saran wrap. The zip-loc is preferred because of easier handling during judging. Participants may enter one item in any of the five classes, so a participant may enter a total of five items. Items that require refrigeration are not allowed. Please label bottom of item with 4-H'ers name and class, so that the participants name is not seen during judging. If you have any questions, please call the Extension office.
