2024 Summer Heifer Validation

Validation is for all Fall 2024 Major Livestock Shows and good for all spring 2025 majors

DEADLINE: March 28, 2024

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- Only one order form per family or one order from per Chapter- Heifers will only be validated in one exhibitors name (If ordering for a chapter please provide names and contacts for everyone who will be tagging heifers)
- Order **all the tags** you feel necessary, the Extension office **does not order "extra" tags**
- Refunds will not be given
- Order **form & payment** must be physically in the **McLennan County Extension office** by the above deadline. If you mail the order, make sure it arrives **on or before** the above deadline.
- There will be no orders taken by phone, fax, or email
- All heifers must be in the exhibitors name by June 30, 2024 and we must have a physical copy of the papers uploaded by June 30, 2024 for the heifer to be eligible to show at any of the Fall major show (State Fair of Texas & Heart O' Texas Fair & Rodeo) (on average it takes 2-3 weeks to receive papers from breed associations).
- **NO ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE DEADLINE**
- Once a heifer is validated she is eligible for her entire show career unless she changes ownership or changes breed.
- **Validation will be in June**
- **ORDERING TAGS DOES NOT ENTER AN EXHIBITOR INTO ANY SHOW**
